Starting Saturday, Nov. 1, the Burleson Public Library will begin offering two levels of memberships.

Library customers will be eligible for a library card if they live in Burleson or own property within the Burleson city limits. If they are a non-resident (do not pay City taxes), they can purchase an annual membership for \$25 (single user) or \$50 for a family membership. All memberships include an unlimited number of checkouts.

The Internet-only and \$5 punch cards will expire on Nov. 1, but library customers who have punch cards can have the remaining balance credited to an annual membership.

To apply for a library card, stop by the library at 248 S.W. Johnson Ave. and fill out an application. You must have photo identification. If you are under 18 you must have your parent or legal guardian with you. If the address on your identification is not current, the library staff will accept other forms of identification that show your address, including a printed personal check, utility bill, first class mail, vehicle insurance card, vehicle registration, lease agreement or pay stub.

The Burleson Public Library offers weekly story times, an after-school teen room, and a large selection of books, DVDs, and music CDs as well as computers with Internet access.
