

Menu for cleaner water



Grease & Oil

Recycle grease and oil. **Don't** pour them into sinks, floor drains or onto a parking lot, alley, sidewalk, street or curb inlet.

Grease traps should be routinely cleaned. If your grease trap overflows, immediately contact your waste hauler and notify the city.



Dumpsters

Keep dumpster area clean and the lid closed. **Don't** fill dumpster with liquid waste or hose it out. Make sure that the drain plug has not been removed and that the dumpster is not leaking. If your dumpster is leaking, contract your dumpster provider for a new one.



Spills

Use dry methods for spill cleanup (sweeping, cat litter, etc.) and place solid waste in trash. **Don't** hose down spills.



Floormats, Filters & Garbage Cans

Clean floormats, filters and garbage cans in a mop sink or floor drain. **Don't** wash them in a parking lot, alley, sidewalk, street or curb inlet.



Mop Water

Pour washwater into a janitorial or mop sink. **Don't** pour it out onto a parking lot, alley, sidewalk, street or curb inlet.
