The City's public works department will be modifying the traffic signal at the intersection of Alsbury Boulevard and Renfro Street on Thursday, Dec. 11, beginning at 9 a.m. The intersection will be controlled with temporary stop signs in all directions.

The control cabinet that houses all of the components to operate the signal is being removed, leveled and raised to allow for easier access for maintenance operations at this location. Additionally, the system is being prepared for the installation of a camera detection system, at a future date, that will replace the in-pavement detector loops. The cameras will take on the roll of detecting when there is a vehicle in the intersection, triggering the traffic signal to change and maximizing intersection efficiency.

This cabinet removal, leveling and raising should be completed within three hours, however, if there are any complications, this time could be extended. The City's public works department asks motorists to be patient as they work to complete the project and minimize any inconvenience it may cause.
