With a large turnout expected for the first of what hopes to become an annual Burleson Old Town Boo Bash, the City will be closing streets on Friday, Oct. 31, to keep trick-or-treaters safe.

Ellison Street, which runs in front of Burleson City Hall, will be closed from Johnson Avenue (behind the police department) to just west of Main Street, by the railroad tracks. Bransom Street will be closed on both the north and south side of Ellison. Warren Street will be closed from Renfro Street to south of Ellison and Wilson Street will be closed from the city hall parking lot to south of Ellison.

The City of Burleson stage will be set up at the corner of Ellison and Wilson streets, next to the Heritage Museum and Visitors Center and the pumpkin patch.

City staff, the Burleson Police Department's sworn bicycle patrol unit, Citizens on Patrol, and the Burleson High School's criminal justice students will be coordinating traffic and parking.

The festival opens at 6 p.m. and closes at 9 p.m.
