In an effort to accommodate the busy schedules of Burleson's citizens, the City of Burleson is expanding its hours at Burleson City Hall and the Municipal Service Center.

Starting Monday, Sept. 29, city hall and the service center will be open for business, 7 a.m.-6 p.m., Monday-Thursday, and 8 a.m.-5 p.m. on Friday for a three-month trial period. Residents will be able to pay their water bill, get a garage sale permit, file an open records request, and apply for a job at city hall as well as pick up lids for their recycling bins at the service center.

"We hope this flexibility will provide opportunities to better serve the public," Deputy City Manager David Wynn said.

Hours at the animal shelter, golf course, senior center, community center, library, municipal court, police department and fire department will not change.
