The Burleson Fire Department and Burleson Professional Fire Fighters Association Local #4025 are joining with fire fighters across Texas to honor Breast Cancer Awareness in a big way. The “Cares Enough to Wear Pink” campaign was adopted by resolution by the Texas State Association of Fire Fighters (TSAFF) to honor women who battle cancer.

Burleson fire fighters are wearing and selling pink T-shirts that sport the National Breast Cancer Awareness Month’s pink ribbon logo. All proceeds above the cost of producing the shirts will go to the Tarrant County affiliate of the Susan G. Komen For the Cure in Fort Worth.

There is a limited supply of t-shirts. The cost is \$20. The sizes range from adult small to 2X. Checks should be made out to BPPFA. The shirts will be for sale starting Friday, Oct. 16, and will only be sold through Oct. 31 at Fire Station #1, located at 828 S.W. Alsbury Blvd.

The fire fighters will be wearing the pink t-shirts Monday, Tuesday, and Wednesday of next week. All other City employees will be allowed to wear the t-shirts on Friday, Oct. 30. The front of the shirt has the Burleson Fire Department’s Maltese cross with the breast cancer ribbon in the center and the back of the shirt has “Burleson Fire Department” with the breast cancer ribbon serving as the “I” in Fire.
