A portion of your regular ticket price, and concessions, for movies beginning after 5 p.m. will be donated to the Burleson Opportunity Fund. If you want to make it a night to remember, purchase a VIP ticket for just \$35 and you will be treated to the red carpet experience . . . dinner, entertainment, photo opportunities, movie star gift bags and tickets to the movie of your choice. The VIP reception begins at 7 p.m.



Tickets for movies after 6 p.m. are \$9 for adults and \$6.50 for children and senior citizens.

The Burleson Opportunity Fund is a joint venture of the City of Burleson, Burleson Independent School District, Hill College at Burleson and community sponsors. The Burleson Opportunity Fund is a scholarship program open to all high school graduates who live or attend school in Burleson. Currently students of the Burleson Opportunity Fund have been guaranteed a one-year 100 percent tuition and fees scholarship to attend Hill College at Burleson. The scholarships fund 32 credit hours per student. Each person awarded is required to take a minimum of 12 hours per semester at Hill College.

Twenty-seven students from Burleson High School and Crossroads High School were tapped for scholarships in 2008. In 2009, 39 students were awarded Burleson Opportunity Fund scholarships to Hill College.

No matter what movie you pick, you will hear more about the Burleson Opportunity Fund during the previews in the cinema's 14 theaters thanks to a Burleson Opportunity Fund video produced in 2008. One of your movie options on Nov. 3 will be *The Imposter*, a Christian movie produced by Daniel Millican, who also produced the Burleson Opportunity Fund video. Parts of *The Imposter* were filmed in Burleson's Old Town as well as at other local sites.
