Put on your costume, grab a treat bag, and head to Burleson's Old Town for the second annual Burleson Old Town Boo Bash. The fun, all of it free, will take place Saturday, Oct. 31, 6 p.m.-8 p.m. Last year, the first-time event drew 5,000-7,000 people. Target is back as the major sponsor of the event.

This year, some of the focus will be taken off of Ellison Street. Instead, Boo Bash will go around a square bound by Eldred Street, Bransom Street, Bufford Street and Ellison. Foot traffic will be one-way to help cut down on the congestion. Directional signs will be posted.



Boo Bash is free trick-or-treating for children from birth to 12 years old. Local businesses, churches and civic groups will set up booths and decorate their vehicles for trunk-or-treat fun. The four blocks of Boo Bash will include candy, games, bounce houses, a pumpkin patch full of free pumpkins for the children to pick out and decorate, and an outdoor Boo Maze. The fun will again include a costume parade for all of the trick-or-treaters.
