Model aircraft aficionados and military veterans won't want to miss the World War II military aircraft models on display in the front lobby of Burleson City Hall.

Burleson Firefighter Rob Moore crafted each of the more than a dozen military planes by hand. He donated the aircraft to the City to display over the Fourth of July holiday.

All of the aircraft are built to a 148 scale, meaning they are each 1/48th the size of the actual aircraft. The United States, Great Britain and Nazi Germany are all represented.

Moore served in the United States Marine Corps Reserves for eight years and as a Fort Worth Police officer for 10 years. He is still a reserve officer for Fort Worth. Moore joined the Burleson Fire Department as a volunteer in January 2006 and was hired as a career firefighter in April 2009.



The model aircraft will be on display at Burleson City Hall through Monday, July 6. City hall is open today, July 2, until 5 p.m., then closed July 3-5. City hall will be open for business 8 a.m.-6 p.m. on Monday, July 6.
