On June 12, the streets rang with a rockabilly tribute to Elvis Presley. On June 19, Burleson's Old Town will resound with strains of Gypsy jazz combined with Western Swing thanks to the Texas Gypsies band.

The Texas Gypsies will headline the fourth of five free Hot Sounds of Summer concerts in Burleson's Old Town on June 19. The music focuses on the 1930s and 1940s and pop and jazz standards. The 90-minute concert starts

at 7:30 p.m. at the corner of Ellison and Wilson streets, next to Burleson City Hall.

The free Hot Sounds of Summer concerts are hosted by the City of Burleson's parks and recreation department. The concert series started May 29 with The Killdares, a Celtic Rock group and was followed by Crawfish on June 5 and Victor Trevino and the Hound Dogs on June 12. The fifth concert features The Derailers (country tribute to Buck Owens) on June 26. The final concert, the Fourth of July celebration at Hidden Creek Sports Complex, will feature Men In Black (Johnny Cash/Roy Orbison tribute).
