Everyone interested in the preservation of trees and natural resources in the city is invited to attend a presentation about the City of Burleson's proposed tree preservation ordinance on Saturday, Feb. 7, at 1 p.m. at the Burleson Public Library.

Community and Development Director Shai Roos presented the concept to Burleson City Council members at the Jan. 20 council meeting. The proposal was developed through the cooperation of the City 's community development department, parks and recreation department, and several community leaders and developers, including Royle Cox, Neal Jones, James Moody, Walter Norwood, Dan Steblay and Peter Thomas.

The goal of the proposed ordinance is to enhance the quality of life, the environmental quality and the aesthetic quality of Burleson. The plan includes both a tree replacement zone and a tree preservation zone.
