To receive temporary power, the following stipulations must be met:

1. Owner and/or General Contractor shall insure that the electrical wiring on said premises will be installed in accordance with the safety requirement of the City of Burleson Electrical Code and all pertinent Electrical Ordinances of the City of Burleson.
2. If upon inspection of said premises wiring is not approved, Owner and/or General Contractor will make necessary changes to conform to the requirements of the City of Burleson.
3. Final inspection must be approved and all reinspection fees must be paid before certificate of occupancy can be issued.

The Owner and/or General Contractor agrees to release the City of Burleson and its agents from any and all liability of every kind and nature for damage to persons and/or property which may occur from defective wiring methods and/or electrical equipment on said premises or from failure to inspect said wiring methods and/or electrical equipment and hereby agrees to indemnify the City of Burleson and its agents for and to hold the City of Burleson and its agents harmless from any and all such liability.
