

Special Session  
December 13, 2005

The Burleson City Council met in a special session on December 13, 2005, in the Burleson City Hall, 141 W. Renfro, Burleson, Texas. Mayor Shetter called the meeting to order at 6:37 P.M., with the following members present: Ken Shetter, Stuart Gillaspie, Matt Powell, Claudia Humphreys, Chip Stephens, Jim Bailey and Jerry Allen.

City Manager, Bill Davison; Deputy City Manager, Curtis E. Hawk; Deputy City Manager, Paul Cain; other staff and other interested citizens were also present.

Mayor Shetter opened the public hearing on the creation of a Reinvestment Zone to promote development or redevelopment of the area consisting of approximately 720 acres of land fully contained in Johnson County, encompassing the Old Town District of Burleson and including property to the east of I-35 and south of Spinks Airport and north of Renfro and property to the west along the 174 corridor at 6:38 P.M.

Laura Moncrief, 241 S. Wilson St., Burleson Texas spoke in opposition to the creation of the Reinvestment Zone.

Ricard Nash, 225 S. Warren, Burleson, Texas spoke in opposition to the creation of the Reinvestment Zone.

There being no more speakers Mayor Shetter closed the public hearing at 7:23 P.M.

Motion was made by Matt Powell and second by Chip Stephens to approve Ordinance C-592, designating Reinvestment Zone Number Two in the City of Burleson, Texas and creating a board of directors for the zone on first reading.

Motion passed 7-0.

There being no further business, the Mayor declared the meeting adjourned.
