B. I-35W Lane Closure

I-35 lane closure

Feb. 3, 2021

BURLESON – The southbound I-35W exit lane and exit to Bethesda Road (Exit 32) will be closed from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. Monday, Feb. 8 for sign installation.

TxDOT encourages attention to all warning signs within the work zone as crews work to complete this work as quickly and safely as possible.

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The Texas Department of Transportation is responsible for maintaining 80,000 miles of road and for supporting aviation, maritime, rail and public transportation across the state.

C. City Council Question

At a recent City Council meeting, Councilmember Reading inquired about the Roadway Impact Fee credit qualification of an offsite roadway that is not included in the city's current Master Thoroughfare Plan. Staff reviewed the local government code with City Attorney Allen Taylor and determined a roadway must be included in the currently adopted Master Thoroughfare Plan to qualify for credits against Roadway Impact Fees.

D. Clark Park survey

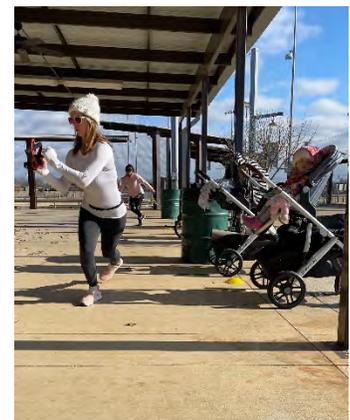
E. BTX Giving Day

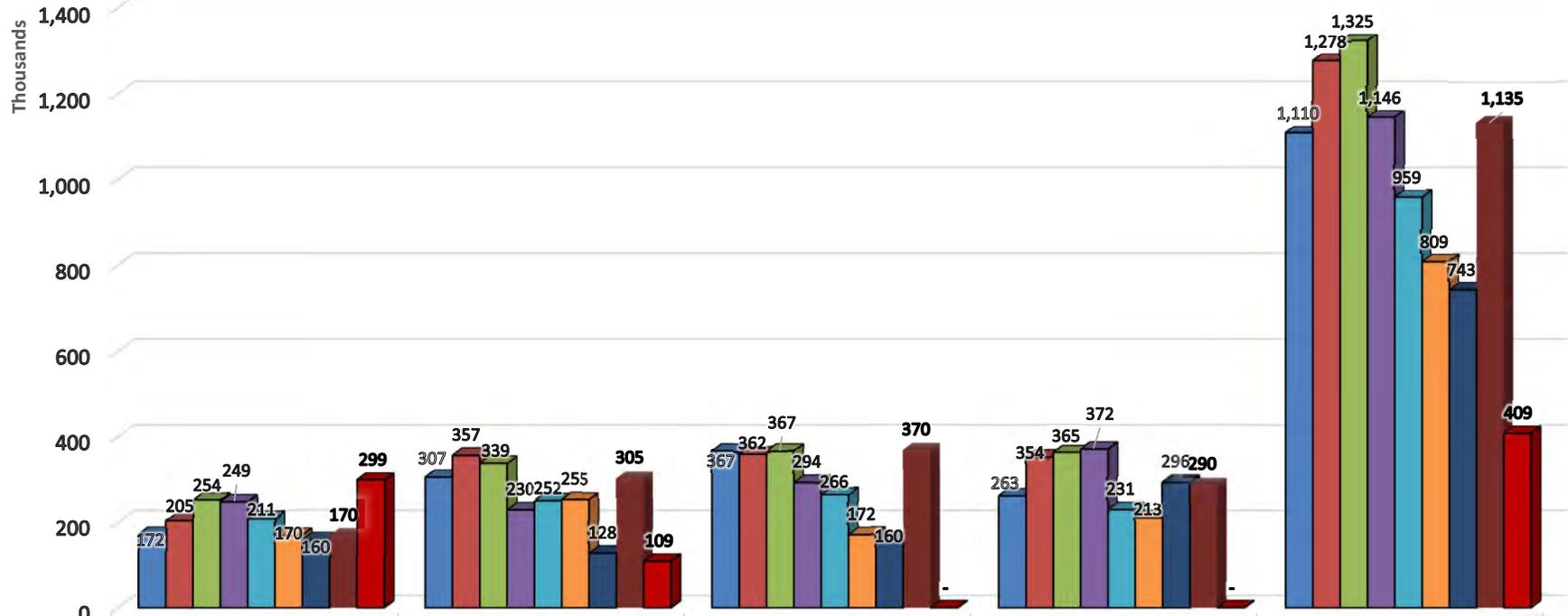

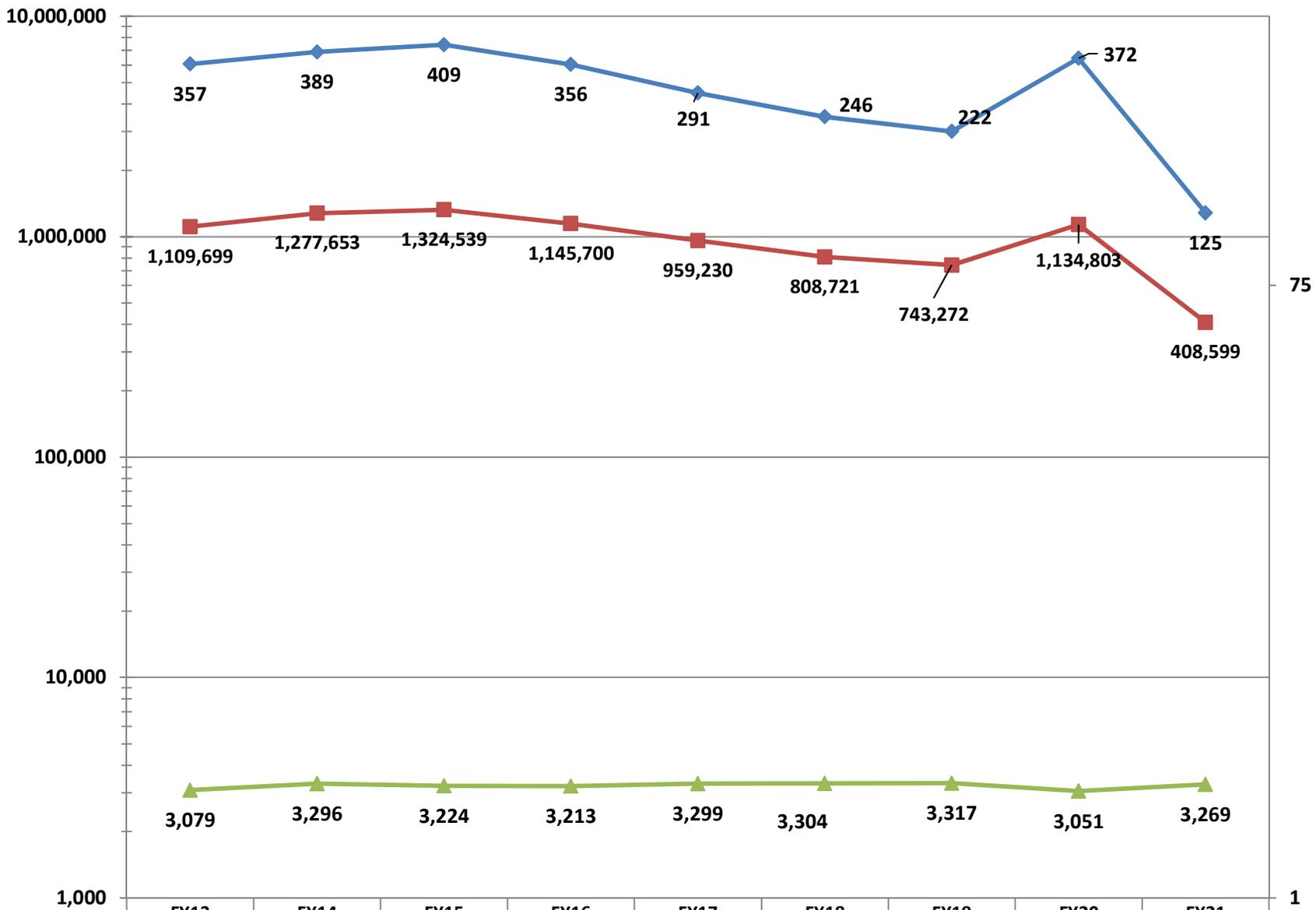

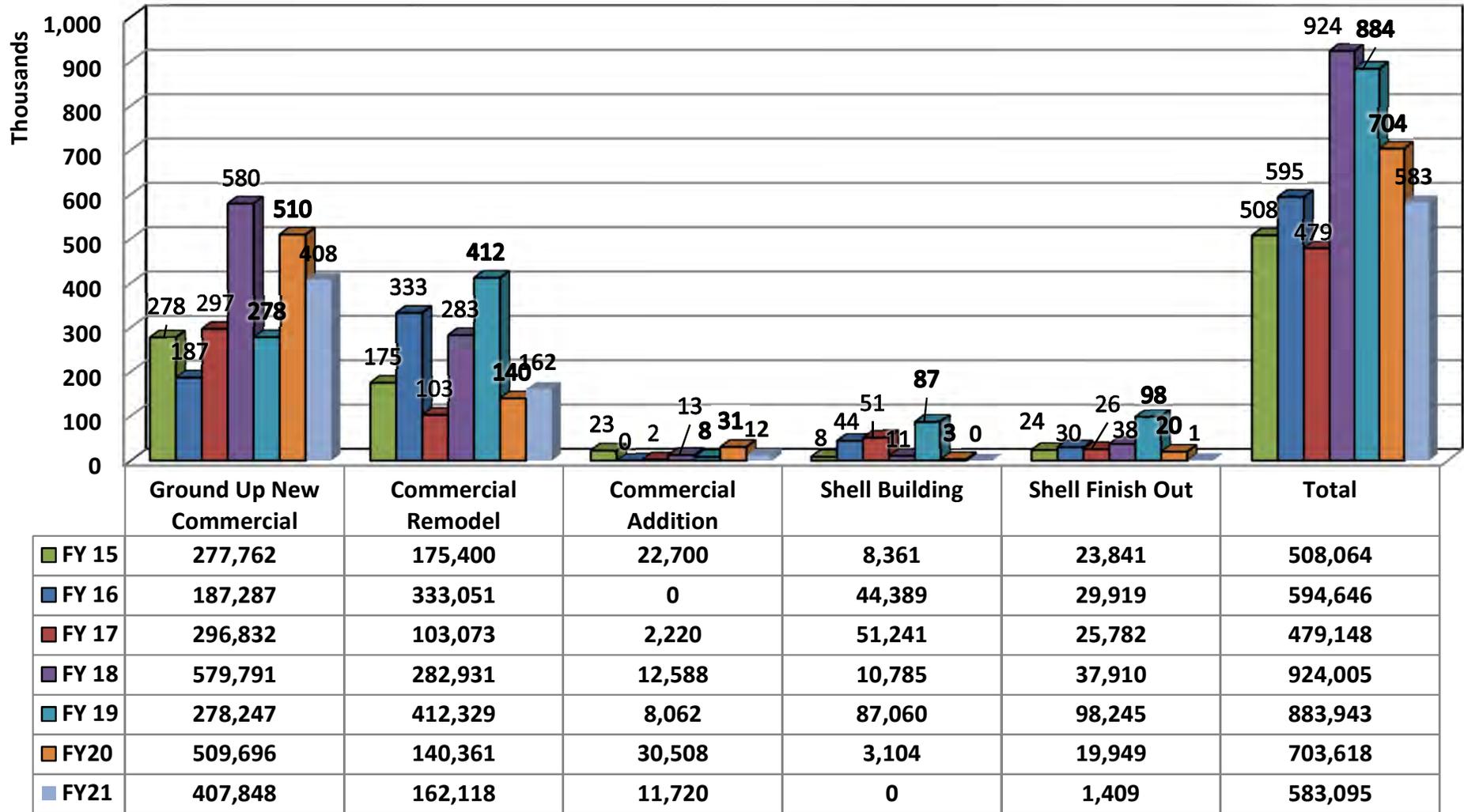

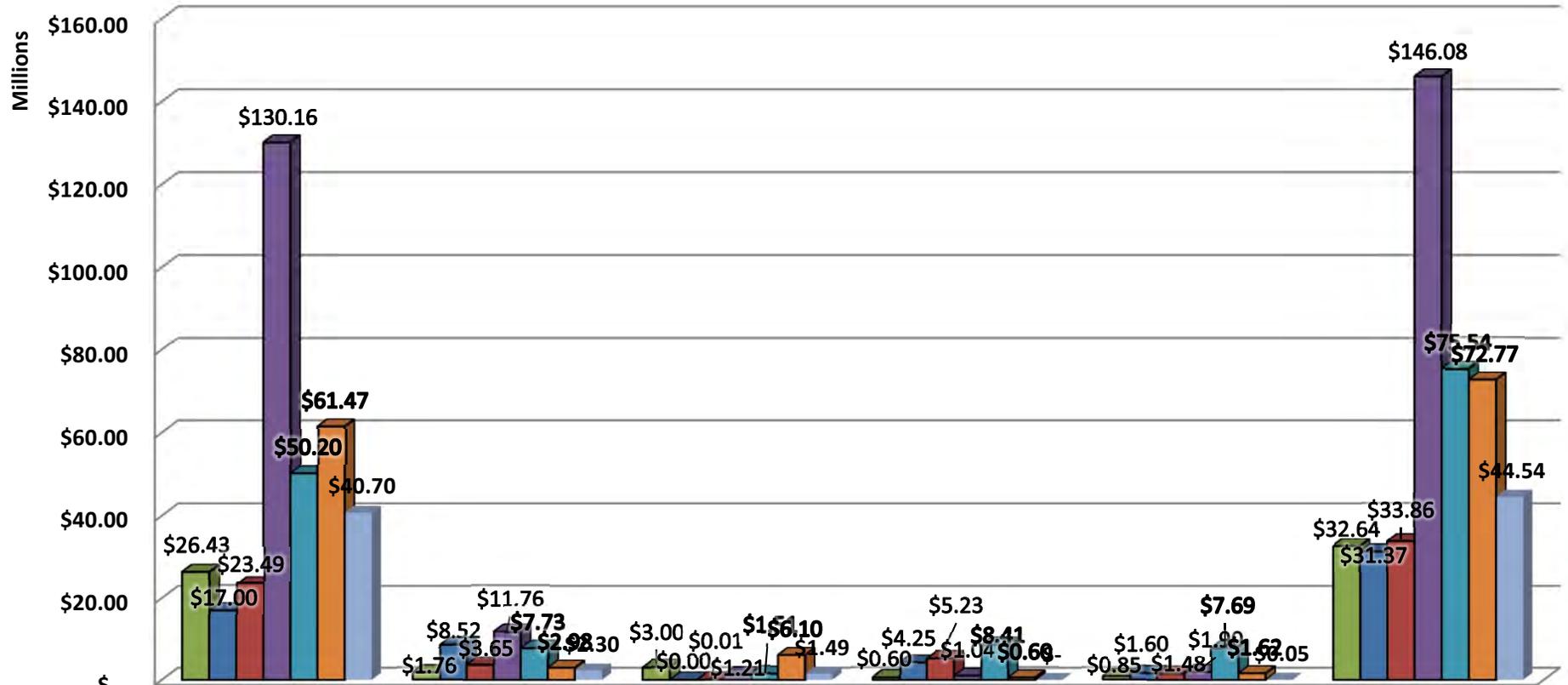
