A. Runoff Election Day





All registered voters can vote in the election, you did not need to vote in the May 1 election to vote in this election.

C. June 8 Planning and Zoning Commission Meeting

There were two items scheduled for the Planning and Zoning Commission on June 8 – a zone change for additional land in the Hunter Place development on East Renfro and a zone change for 204, 208, & 216 S. Main for the Station 330 restaurant. The Star-Telegram failed to publish the public notices for these items. At the point at which staff was notified of the failure to publish, it was too late for legal notice timeframes; therefore, these items will be delayed to the June 22 P&Z meeting.

The applicants have been notified and updated notices have been mailed to surrounding property owners. These were the only two items proposed for the June 8 meeting, so there is no need for the P&Z to hold a formal meeting at that time. However, because these items have had formal notice mailed and posted on site, they must be included on an agenda for June 8. Staff will publish an agenda with statements related to the delay in the items and staff will be at City Hall during the normal meeting time to visit with anyone from the public that attends. Staff will expedite these items to City Council so that the final approval date is maintained. There should be no disruption to the applicants' schedules. D. Warren Park Playground Maintenance

The playgrounds at Warren Park will be temporarily **closed** for termite treatment on Tuesday, June 8, 2021 and will **reopen** on Wednesday, June 9, 2021. Termites have been observed feeding on the engineered wood fiber that serves as the approved playground surfacing. E. NCTCOG Celebrating Leadership in Development Excellence (CLIDE) Award

The Mayor Vera Calvin Plaza in Old Town is a 2021 Celebrating Leadership in Development Excellence (CLIDE) Award winner.

On April 29, 2021, a nationally recognized jury of experts in the fields of architecture, urban planning, and development deliberated and chose the distinguished awardees from the 2021 CLIDE Award applications. Among the 26 applications, the City of Burleson's project was identified by the jurors as one that greatly exemplifies one or more of the Principles of Development Excellence, and one that they feel provides an example of Development Excellence in the North Central Texas region.

As part of this award program, staff, and representatives from the design (TBG Partners, architecture (Bennet Partners), construction (Hill & Wilkinson), and engineering (Dunaway) teams accepted the award and recognition virtually at the North Central Texas Council of Governments' (NCTCOG) annual General Assembly on Friday, June 4.
