II. General Information and Status Updates

A. Ground-Based Mosquito Spraying in Zones 2, 3, 8 and 12 this weekend

On September 1, 2021, the City's environmental services division was notified that four mosquito traps tested positive for West Nile virus.

The areas are:

- **Zone 2** is in the area of Houston Road, Renfro Street and Cindy Court [View Map](#)
- **Zone 3** is in the area of Wilshire Boulevard, Wildwood lane, Oakbrook Drive, Lakeside Drive, Clubhouse Dirve, Shoreline Drive, and Glenn Ranch Drive [View Map](#)
- **Zone 8** is in the area of Gregory St, Warren St, Miller St, Dobson St, Hidden Creek Pkwy, Hidden Vistas Blvd, Irene St, Arnold Ave, Elk Dr, and Wilshire Blvd. [View Map](#)
- **Zone 12** is in the area Hidden Creek Parkway, Hidden Vistas Blvd, Big Horn Dr, Valley Crest Dr, Cozby Ln, Hidden Lake Dr, and Hidden Oaks Drive [View Map](#)

The City of Burleson will conduct ground-based spraying for mosquitoes between 9 p.m. and 6 a.m. on Friday, September 3, and then again on Saturday, September 4. The ground spraying will be performed in targeted subdivision within the designated spray zones.

In the event of rain or if wind speeds are above 10 miles per hour, the spraying may be rescheduled. This method of spraying targets flying mosquitoes that come in contact with the pesticide in the spray or fog. These times have been chosen because they are the times that most mosquitoes are active (flying).


B. COVID Updates

D. Labor Day Closures

Most city facilities will be closed on Monday, Sept. 6. The exceptions are the BRiCk which will be open from 8 a.m. – 5 p.m. and Hidden Creek Golf Course is open for regular play from 6 a.m. – 8 p.m.

Trash/curbside recycling will not be affected by the holiday and will run as scheduled. The Burleson City Council meeting will take place on Tuesday, Sept. 7 since city facilities will be closed on Monday which is council's regularly scheduled meeting date.

E. Claudia's Playground: Update on Slide Replacements

As first reported on June 11, due to vandalism that resulted in irreparable damages, both slides at Claudia's playground were closed until replacement components were installed. A barrier was installed at the entrance of each slide to prevent injury. The order for replacement features and installation service was finalized on June 30. At that time, a shipping date was projected by the vendor for September 1 (6-8 weeks for major playground parts is typical even during normal markets). Staff received notice from the

vendor this week of a new expected shipping date of **September 15** due to COVID setbacks experienced by the manufacturing plant. Expected delivery to the installer is **October 1** and at that time, the installer will provide the city with the scheduled installation date.

F. Keep Burleson Beautiful makes Call for Artists




