

This new webpage outlines more than 70 performance metrics spanning every major department/division in the city, giving a detailed and transparent view of key performance metrics aligned directly with city

This site will allow staff to track their progress toward clearly defined and benchmarked goals and help identify areas for improvement across the entire organization. As transparency and accountability are chief elements of the city's strategic plan, this new site will give citizens a better understanding of how the city operates and the results we are achieving. Each metric is linked dynamically to backend data and explains why the metric is important and how it is being calculated. The monthly outdoor warning siren test is scheduled for noon Wednesday, May 3 (tests are held the first Wednesday of every month, if weather permits).


F. Feel Good Friday
