II. GENERAL AND STATUS UPDATES

A. CITY HALL RENOVATION TO BEGIN MONDAY, FEB. 24

The renovation of city hall, which includes a new council workroom, new city secretary offices and updated bathrooms, will begin Monday, Feb. 24. During construction, there will be minor changes to city operations.



The city hall public parking lot on the east side of the building will be fenced off for the contractor's use, including a dumpster, portable toilets and material staging.

Access to city hall will be limited to the front vestibule, except during public meetings. Residents will have access to public meeting notices, and a phone in the vestibule will connect callers to 311 for assistance.

Construction is expected to take three to four months.


B. LIBRARY PROGRAMMING


E. FEEL GOOD FRIDAY
