Spring is coming, which is the prime time for coyotes to start roaming. The City's Animal Services has some simple ways to keep your family and animals safe from coyotes.

- Keep your garbage in a secure container, and only place it outside the morning of your scheduled collection.
- Do not leave any pet food or meat scraps out overnight.
- Cut back any brush surrounding your property because brush makes a good den for coyotes.
- Do not let your own animals roam freely; small dogs and cats are at a high risk as they are prey for coyotes.
