Strains of Stevie Ray Vaughan music, courtesy of Voodoo Blue, will fill the air at Chisenhall Fields as the City hosts the annual Independence Day celebration on Monday, July 4.

The 90-minute concert starts at 7:30 p.m., and will be followed by the fireworks show, which is choreographed to music.

Voodoo Blue performed at the 2010 Hot Sounds of Summer concert series in Burleson's Old Town. According to the band's website, Voodoo Blue formed in 2002 with one purpose in mind – to pay homage to one of the most widely recognized guitar masters – Stevie Ray Vaughan. Stevie, with his band Double Trouble, electrified audiences with their brand of rockin' Texas blues.

Voodoo Blue has appeared with Lynyrd Skynyrd, The Allman Brothers Band, Molly Hatchet, Jonny Lang, Jeff Healey, Johnny Winter, and more. Voodoo Blue can be seen at Metroplex venues such as The Keys Lounge, Flying Pig Road House, Jacks Back Yard, Jack's Porch, Hank's, Coach Joe's and Z Grill & Tap.
