Constructing medians on Hwy. 174 from I-35W to John Jones Drive in Burleson has the support of City staff and city council. Does it have the community's support?

The Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) and the City will host an open house on Tuesday, Sept. 27, 6 p.m.-8 p.m. at city hall (141 W. Renfro St.). TxDOT is in the design stage of a construction project to add raised concrete medians in place of the center left turn lane. The project is scheduled for construction in 2012.

The project would remove and replace the aging roadway surface (milling, overlay and striping) and improve safety by constructing a raised center median in place of the two way continuous left turn lane. TxDOT personnel will have maps, drawings, and other information about the project at the open house to show the location and proposed route. There will be no formal presentation.

The proposed median is fully funded by the Federal Highway Administration and TxDOT. Possible landscaping and irrigation of those medians would be funded by the City.
