Local military veterans can still be immortalized with a brick at Burleson Veterans Memorial Park in Renfro Square. Approximately 1,240 bricks have been sold, with room for 100 more.

Stop by the Burleson Public Library, 248 S.W. Johnson Ave., and request a Brick for Veterans order form, or go to the City website, www.burlesontx.com, Library, Bricks For Veterans. The brick includes the name of the veteran, branch of service, and the name of the conflicts, if any. An engraved seal representing that veteran's branch of service is also included. The cost is \$45 per brick. Mail your payment to the Burleson Public Library, 248 S.W. Johnson Ave., Burleson, TX 76028. Enclose a check or money order when submitted by mail. You can also make your payment at the library via cash, check or credit card.

The Burleson Bricks for Veterans project began in 2007 with the vision of community volunteer Betty Shelton and B&G businessman Rocky Bransom. The memorial began as a fountain with room for 200 bricks that would be inlaid in the sidewalk that surrounds the fountain. That number quickly grew to 900, then to more than 1,200.

The interactive kiosk at Veterans Memorial Park, 298 E. Renfro St., allows visitors to search for a military veteran by name, branch, war or geographic location. It also allows access to the personal histories and other stories about the service of the military veterans whose names are memorialized at the park.

The Burleson Public Library took over administration of the Burleson Bricks for Veterans program in late 2008. Burleson Monument Design and MFG, Inc. provide the engraving.
