A high-tech update of the traditional bookmobile is making Burleson one of three north Texas stops on the national tour.

Overdrive's Digital Bookmobile, which is inside a 74-foot 18-wheel tractor-trailer, will be at the Burleson Public Library on Wednesday, Nov. 2, between noon and 6 p.m. There is no charge to participate in the event and the exhibits. The library is located at 248 S.W. Johnson Ave. (corner of Johnson and Newton Street).

The Digital Bookmobile is a community outreach vehicle for public libraries to promote downloadable eBooks, audiobooks, music and video. The vehicle is equipped with broadband Internet-connected computers, high-definition monitors, premium sound systems, and a variety of portable media players. Interactive computer stations give visitors a chance to search the digital media collection and 'Virtual Branch' download website, use supported mobile devices, and sample eBooks and audiobooks from the library.

Burleson is one of three libraries in the North Texas Libraries On-the-Go Overdrive consortium and one of more than 12 in Texas to be picked for a stop on the national tour. On Oct. 31, the bookmobile will be at The Keller Public Library. On Nov. 2 it will be in Burleson, then on Nov. 3 the digital bookmobile will be at The Colony Public Library.

The bookmobile will be set up in the parking lot on the Newton Street side of the library. Overflow parking will be at Warren Park, across the street from the library.
