Hidden Creek Golf Course is getting a whole new look thanks to a redesign and realignment.

The City's municipal course will close the back nine holes effective Monday, Jan. 9. That includes Holes 10-18. The front nine holes, Holes 1-9, are slated to close in mid-February. All 18 holes will reopen in the fall of 2012, barring any weather delays during the redesign.

The realignment includes creating a new irrigation lake and increasing water storage capacity; improving the quality of play and potential revenue of the course; eliminating significant design flaws (for example, the distance between Hole 17 and Hole 18); renovation and realignment of 12 golf holes; updating the branding of the course and merchandising; and relocating the 18th hole to allow for future development of Hidden Creek Parkway. Colligan Golf Design is doing the realignment.

The redesign and realignment will open Hidden Creek Golf Course up for championship tournaments and qualifying events.

The course will be closed, but the pro shop, range, and the restaurant will remain open. The pro shop will be open 8:30 a.m.-4:30 p.m., seven days a week. The range will remain open temporarily, and the restaurant will stay open for lunch, 10 a.m.-2 p.m., Monday-Friday. The pro shop is fully stocked with all the latest gear and clothing and major brands. The practice facilities include a bunker, putting green and driving range. The Hidden Creek Grill serves sandwiches and specials, including hamburger or grilled chicken baskets for lunch. Eat and relax with the big-screen TVs indoors or with a view of the course and the city from the covered patio.
