The Mayor's Youth Council was created May 10, 2007, via a Burleson City Council resolution. The city council officially appointed the first youth council in January 2008.

The Mayor's Youth Council is made up of youth, 13-19 years of age, who live in Burleson or the extra-territorial jurisdiction, have a passion to be the voice of Burleson youth, and show leadership qualities within the community. These youth are nominated by teachers, parents, principals, pastors and neighbors. They help the Burleson City Council identify current issues affecting area youth.
