The terms of six of the 13 members of the Burleson Mayor's Youth Council will expire May 31, 2012, so the council is looking for some fresh faces to fill those shoes.

Nominations for youth members are rolling nominations, meaning that the adult nomination form is available online year round. However, for youth to be considered for appointment to the youth council for the two-year term beginning June 1, they must be nominated by an adult by 5 p.m. on March 30.

Youth may be nominated by family members, teachers, youth pastors, and neighbors. Youth must live in the Burleson city limits or the Burleson extra-territorial jurisdiction (ETJ) and must be between 13 and 18 years old.

To nominate a youth for the Mayor's Youth Council, go to the City website, www.burlesontx.com/MYC, and click on the "Join Us" link. Scroll to the bottom of the page and select Adult Nomination. Once a youth is nominated for the council, that youth will be notified and asked to fill out the Youth Questionnaire. To remain eligible for a term beginning on June 1, the youth must turn the form in by April 6. Personal interviews will be scheduled for April 17 and April 19. The youth who are chosen will be appointed at a Burleson City Council meeting in May.
