A 63-year-old Burleson woman died Thursday in an automobile/pedestrian crash in south Burleson.

DATE/TIME: March 1, 4:11 p.m.

LOCATION: 300 block of Southeast John Jones Road.

VICTIM: Connie Hunter, 63, Burleson

DRIVER/VEHICLE: John Tubbs, 61, Burleson/silver 2001 Ford four-door vehicle

The crash report is not complete. According to preliminary information the driver was in the 300 block of Southeast John Jones. He slowed to change to the right traffic lane. When his vehicle entered the right lane, it struck Hunter, who was standing in the lane of traffic as she attempted to cross the road en route to Shenandoah Townhomes. The driver was unable to see Hunter prior to changing lanes because there was a vehicle in front of him.

Burleson Police, Burleson Fire, MedStar Ambulance and CareFlite responded to the scene. CareFlite transported Hunter to a Fort Worth hospital where she was later pronounced dead.

No charges are pending against the driver at this time.
