The City will be celebrating a truly Centennial event with the dedication of the City's first fully accessible park for children of all abilities on Saturday, April 7, at 10 a.m. Centennial Park (formerly Burleson Meadows Park) is located at 1100 Scarlet Sage Pkwy., off of McAlister Road.

This park will allow physically challenged children and able-bodied children to play together. The surface of the playground equipment is a mixture of a rubberized material and engineered wood fiber to aid in mobility. A shade structure shields the playground. Ramps are ADA compliant.

The park also includes an 18-space parking lot, concrete walk, concrete pad for a future pavilion, landscaping, minimal irrigation, drinking fountain, trash cans, benches and a restroom.

Also coming for the city's newest park will be another centennial celebration slated for Nov. 3 . . . the planting of the City's Veteran's Grove. Through the efforts of citizens community-wide, 100 native Texas trees will be planted at the park to honor the men and women who serve or have served in the armed forces. The trees are being furnished by the City and TXU Energy.
