A 26-year-old Burleson woman was killed Monday in a three-vehicle crash in the 1600 block of Houston Road.

VICTIM: Cassie Marie Reeves

DATE/TIME: Monday, April 23, 2012; 4:38 p.m.

LOCATION: 1600 block of Houston Road

Burleson firefighters extricated the victim from the 2006 Chevrolet Impala that she was driving. MedStar ambulance and Care Flite Air helicopter responded to the crash.

According to the traffic investigator, witnesses state that the Impala was traveling west in the 1600 block of Houston Road at a high rate of speed when Reeves lost control of the car, crashed into two Ford F-150 pickups, then landed in a ditch. Reeves was pronounced dead at the scene. Houston Road is a two-lane road.

A 26-year-old Arlington man, who was the driver of the first pickup that was struck, was transported by Care Flite Air to a Fort Worth hospital. He was treated and released. The 31-year-old male driver of the second pickup refused medical treatment at the scene.

The crash is still under investigation.
