Early voting for the May 12 Burleson City Council election starts Monday, April 30.

Vote early at Burleson City Hall, 141 W. Renfro St. Hours are Monday, April 30-Saturday, May 5, 8 a.m.-5 p.m.; and, Monday, May 7-Tuesday, May 8, 7 a.m.-7 p.m. Election Day voting is 7 a.m.-7 p.m.

Three of the four council races on the City ballot are contested.

Mayor

- Ken Shetter (incumbent), 40, is an attorney and executive director. He has lived in Texas for 40 years and in Burleson for 13 years.
- Larry Pool (challenger), 50, is employed in insurance and real estate. He has lived in Texas for 15 years and in Burleson for three years.

Place 2

- Rick Green (incumbent), 47, is employed in real estate. He has lived in Texas for 47 years and in Burleson for 20 years.

Place 4

- Matt Aiken (incumbent), 31, employed as an attorney. He has lived in Texas for 31 years and in Burleson for six years.
- Leslee Clark Ahrend (challenger), 42, employed as a teacher. She is a lifelong resident of Texas and a 20-year resident of Burleson.

Place 6

- Brenda Gammon (challenger), 59, is a financial advisor. She has lived in Texas for 11 years and in Burleson for 11 years.
- Ronnie Johnson (challenger), 66, retired. He is a lifetime resident of Texas and a 39-year resident of Burleson.
- Heather Morrill, 38, is a teacher. She is a six-year resident of Texas and a 5-year resident of Burleson.
