The City will host a public meeting on Wednesday, July 18, to discuss removal and replacement of the brick planters at the entrance to Sierra Vista Estates at the intersection with Alsbury Boulevard. The hour-long meeting is a come-and-go format starting at 6:30 p.m. at the BRiCk, 550 N.W. Summercrest Blvd.

The planters and the brick neighborhood sign were discussed at the July 2 Burleson City Council work session. The main issue is for drivers who are turning from Sierra Vista on to Alsbury Boulevard. The planters are located in the visibility triangle at that intersection. This is private property, there are no easements and there is no homeowners association. The City is proposing to demolish the existing Sierra Vista sign and replace it with a shorter, smaller sign that will belong to the property owners.
