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Six down, 10 to go.

The City's street department has completed the mill and overlay work on six streets and a City contractor will start work on micro surfacing 10 streets on Aug. 7, weather permitting.

The completed streets (paving) are Southwest Thomas (Renfro Street to Candlelite Court), Tarrant Street (Southwest Thomas to just south of the intersection with Tarrant, Ann Lois/Southwest Murphy from Alsbury Boulevard to Charlyne, Suzanne Terrace from Wilshire Boulevard to Hillside, Gamble Street from Southwest Johnson Avenue to Newton Street and Harris Street from Southwest Johnson to Robert Street.

For the next two weeks, street crews will be redoing the pavement markings on Southwest Thomas Street at the approaches to intersections and for traffic at Hughes Middle School. Watch for City crews in this area as they work to finish the marking project prior to the start of school.

The micro surface program will affect Baker Street (in the area of Tabb Street), Clark Street from Renfro to Field Street, Commerce Street from Renfro to Rudd Street, Higgins Street from Clark to Scott Street, East King from Commerce to Clark Street, Tabb Street from Commerce to Burleson Boulevard, Dobson Street from Renfro to Field Street, Scott Street from Renfro to Higgins Street, Northwest King Street from Southwest Murphy to Michael Street and Southwest Murphy from Renfro to Newton Street.

The contractor on the micro surfacing is Viking Construction. The contractor will be posting door hangars on Friday, Aug. 3, to let residents know about the upcoming work. Traffic will not be able to travel on these roads for up to six hours once the micro surfacing begins.
