After a six-month closure, Hidden Creek Golf Course will be open for play on Monday, Oct. 1. The course has been closed since March for a course redesign and realignment. Golf course staff will start taking Oct. 1 tee times on Monday, Sept. 24, at 8 a.m. Call 817-447-4444, extension 5.

The course is re-opening at the old rates. That includes \$30 for weekday prime, \$26 after 11 a.m., \$18 after 3 p.m., and seniors (55 and older) for \$24. On weekends, the rates are \$40 for weekend prime, \$32 after 11 a.m., and \$20 after 3 p.m.

The Restaurant at Hidden Creek Golf Course will be open for business, 7 a.m.-7 p.m., Monday-Sunday, starting Oct. 1. Breakfast will be served until 11 a.m., then lunch is 11 a.m.-2:30 p.m., followed by beverages and “small bites” until closing.

In November 2011, Burleson City Council members approved the full redesign of the seven-year-old City course. The project included the realignment of four holes (a total of 12 holes have substantial renovation), four new green complexes, additional lake (5 acres, 14 feet deep), turf/topsoil/irrigation improvements, and cart path realignment. Colligan Golf Design did the realignment. This redesign and realignment opens Hidden Creek Golf Course up for championship tournaments and qualifying events.
