Burleson Police arrested a Waco man Thursday for the aggravated robbery of the Burleson Dairy Queen in December 2011. In an unrelated case, Burleson Police arrested a Comanche man on Sept. 27 for the aggravated robbery of a Burleson 7-11 store on Aug. 30 of this year.

Arrested for the 2011 aggravated robbery is Daniel James Rockstad, 24.  
Arrested for the 2012 aggravated robbery is Mark Dewayne Rangel, 48.

Rockstad was arrested at work in Waco on Oct. 11 on a warrant for aggravated robbery. Investigators believe Rockstad is the suspect who entered the Dairy Queen in the 200 block of Wilshire Boulevard at 7:28 a.m. on Monday, Dec. 5, 2011. The suspect was armed with a knife and wearing a mask when he confronted the restaurant employee. The suspect took money from Dairy Queen and left in a vehicle.



Rangel was taken into custody by Burleson Police at the Comanche County Sheriff's Office on Sept. 27 in connection with the Aug. 30 aggravated robbery at the 7-11 store in the 100 block of Burleson Boulevard. The suspect in that case was armed with a tire iron. The suspect's head and arms were covered with trash bags, possibly in an attempt to hide tattoos. The suspect took money from the clerk then left the store on foot. A search warrant at Rangel's home in Comanche in September resulted in the recovery of evidence from the robbery. Rangel was arrested for the warrant as well as for a parole violation connected to a previous aggravated robbery.
