The City of Burleson and the Burleson Heritage Foundation will mark the end of the City's Centennial year by burying a time capsule at Centennial Park on Friday, Dec. 21. The ceremony will take place at 10 a.m. The park is located at 1100 Scarlet Sage Pkwy.

The capsule will be buried at the center of the Military Veteran Grove, which was dedicated Nov. 3. Contained in the time capsule will be historical calendars; historical books from the region; local newspapers and magazines; restaurant menus; pictures of City parks; pictures of City, school, and Burleson Heritage Foundation leaders; pictures of local sites; a video and pictures of the two rail cars and the Burleson Visitors Center, and a little military history. The City is preparing a granite monument that will be engraved with the City's Centennial logo and placed atop the time capsule.

Burleson was officially incorporated as a town on May 21, 1912. When Burleson was incorporated, the boundary was approximately .65 square miles (roughly 415 acres). Today, the population is estimated at 38,130 within a boundary of 26.4 miles.

Centennial Park is located at the corner of McAlister Road and Scarlet Sage Parkway. It is also home to the City's first universally accessible park.
