If you live inside the city limits of Burleson, it's easy to recycle your Christmas tree when it begins dropping needles. The City's compost/mulch/recycling center is open 9 a.m.-3 p.m., Tuesday, Friday and Saturday. The center will be closed Tuesday, Dec. 25, and Tuesday, Jan. 1, but will be open Friday and Saturday, Dec. 28-29. The compost/mulch/recycling center is located at 620 Memorial Plaza, behind Fire Station #2. You have to be a resident of the city of Burleson to use the City center.

If you don't want to recycle your holiday tree, set it at the curb along with your regular trash. There will be no trash or curbside recycling collection Tuesday, Dec. 25, or Tuesday, Jan. 1.

Dried-out trees should not be left in the home or garage, or placed outside against the home.
