A man who allegedly robbed the Educational Employees Credit Union on Alsbury Boulevard Saturday afternoon didn't get far. Burleson officers arrested Bentley Mark Jenkins, 45, of Fort Worth on a charge of robbery (strong arm) in the 7200 block of FM 917.

DATE/TIME: Saturday, Feb. 9, 1:04 p.m.

LOCATION OF ROBBERY: EECU, 750 N.E. Alsbury Blvd.

LOCATION/TIME OF ARREST: 7200 block of FM 917, 1:06 p.m.

Officers responded to an alarm at the EECU, which closes at 1 p.m. on Saturdays. Officers were told that the suspect, described as a black male, entered the business before it closed and gave a note to a teller demanding money. The suspect took the money and left the bank.

Witnesses said the suspect fled on Alsbury Boulevard, toward I-35W, in a 2002 gray Mitsubishi. Officers caught up to a vehicle matching that description on I-35W, at Renfro Street. The driver of the Mitsubishi fled from officers. He took the Bethesda Road exit and continued south on Burleson Boulevard (the I-35W service road/frontage road). The driver turned east on FM 917 and crashed into a culvert in the 7200 block of FM 917. The driver, identified as Jenkins, got out of the vehicle. Jenkins was arrested following a foot pursuit.
