There is a full slate of activities for families Saturday, March 23, when the City of Burleson hosts Aqua Egg Hunt, the Bunny Daze Extravaganza, and the new Family Field Day, all at the BRiCk and Bartlett Park. And, the City's Russell Farm is hosting its first ever Easter Egg Hunt at Russell Farm.

Put on your swimsuits and goggles because the fun begins at 10 a.m. with children hunting for plastic eggs in the BRiCk's indoor pool. Children up to age 11 will be divided into four age groups for hunts in the play structure area and the lap pool. The fun starts with children two and younger (with a parent) at 10 a.m.; ages 3-5 at 10:30 a.m.; ages 6-8 at 11 a.m.; and ages 9-11 at 11:30 a.m. Children redeem eggs for prizes. Participation is limited so pre-registration is recommended (call 817-426-9104). Admission is \$2 per child.

Registration for Family Field Day starts at 11 a.m. and closes at 1 p.m. All events will wrap up before the Bunny Daze Easter Egg Hunt at 1:30 p.m. Family Field Day is a Be Healthy Initiative event (City of Burleson and Huguley Hospital partnership) hosted by the Burleson police and fire departments as well as volunteers from HEB, the Burleson Lions Club, Burleson Rotary Club, Boy Scouts of America, Mayor's Youth Council, and Teen Court.

There are six field day events for all ages – children and parents. They include Rapid Radar (how fast and accurate can you throw), Crime Catcher (how fast can you run without dropping the egg off the spoon), Great Getaway (can you and a partner get away quick when your legs are tied together for the three-legged race), Fireman's Drill (how quick can you get ready to put out a fire), House Fire (how quickly can you extinguish the fire in a "burning house") and Fire Hose Tug-of-War. Contestants who compete in all six events will be eligible for a prize. Awards for the Family Field Day events will be presented following the Bunny Daze Easter Egg Hunt.

Bunny Daze is noon-2 p.m., also in Bartlett Park. Bunny Daze is a free event. Bring your children, camera and Easter baskets! There will be on-stage performances, carnival games, face painting, and more. Booth spaces are available for \$20 by calling 817-426-9104. The Easter Bunny will be at Bunny Daze to meet and greet and pose for pictures. The Easter Egg Hunt starts at 1:30 p.m. The children, up to age 12, will be divided into age groups, to hunt for eggs. Prize eggs are also included in the Bunny Daze Easter Egg Hunt.

Join Joey the Easter donkey at 3 p.m. for this year's first ever Easter Egg Hunt at the City's Russell Farm. Joey will be ready to pose for pictures (bring your own camera) and lead in a petting zoo. This event is for children from birth to 4 years old.
