Thanks to the 2013 Texas Warrant Roundup, the Burleson Municipal Court cleared more than 180 warrants and collected more than \$26,000.

Between Feb. 18 and March 10, 187 warrants were cleared, \$26,063 was collected (costs, fees, fines, bonds), and the total face value of all warrants cleared totaled \$54,671. The biggest days for the Municipal Court were Feb. 22 with 24 warrants valued at \$6,673 cleared and March 1 with 22 warrants cleared, at a face value of \$5,317.

As of Feb. 20, the Burleson Municipal Court had approximately 3,100 outstanding warrants valued at more than \$700,000.

The City joined forces with more than 120 law enforcement agencies across the state for the 2013 Great Texas Warrant Roundup. The court extended its Friday hours in February. The focus was on Class C misdemeanor warrants, the majority of which were traffic-related offenses.

If you have a warrant, you may:

- Appear in person at Burleson Municipal Court.
- Pay online by logging on to the City website, www.burlesontx.com, and clicking on the "Online Payments" box. You cannot make partial payments, pay cash bonds, or pay dismissal fees online. Payments received by 4 p.m. are posted on the next business day. MasterCard and Visa are accepted.
- Pay by money order or cashier's check. Mail the payment to Burleson Municipal Court, 247 Elk Dr., Room 114, Burleson, TX 76028. If the payment is mailed, warrant(s) will remain active until the payment is received and posted.
