Burleson Police are seeking one driver, and possibly an accomplice, involved in a hit and run crash in the 300 block of Warren Street. The suspect hit a motor home (recreational vehicle with its own engine), which was parked in a driveway, and pushed the motor home in to the yard. No one was in the motor home at the time. There were no injuries. The damage to the motor home is estimated at \$40,000.

**DATE/TIME:** Sunday, March, 30, 2:21 a.m.

**LOCATION:** 300 block of Warren Street

**SUSPECT VEHICLE:** White Ford truck, possibly 1992-1996 model, with large tires (possibly a lift kit) with a grill or brush guard.

**POSSIBLE ACCOMPLICE:** Black or dark colored dually

The victim's neighbor told police that he heard vehicle tires skidding, then the crash. Another witness said the vehicle left the Warren Street scene and turned on to Gregory Street. Officers did not locate the suspect or the accomplice vehicle, but they did find a headlight, parking light lens, part of a side mirror and other parts that might be from a wheel well. The white Ford Truck should have front end damage as well as damage to the passenger side.
