Hone your computer skills with Computer/Internet Skills classes at the Burleson Public Library.

There are two levels, Basic/Introduction and Step-Up/Intermediate, and both start in June. The basic class is on Mondays, 1 p.m.-3 p.m., June 10-July 29. Intermediate classes are on Wednesdays, 1 p.m.-3 p.m., June 12-July 31. All classes take place in the meeting room at the library. Laptop computers and all materials are provided free of charge. The computers are provided through a grant from the Texas State Library and Archives Commission. Classes are taught by Donna Braun, courtesy of the Cleburne Independent School District.

The Basic/Introduction class provides the how-to on accessing information and programs on the computer for the beginner or those who need to brush up on computer skills. The Step-Up/Intermediate class includes more tips on how to search for information and use the Internet and programs more effectively.
