Bjorn, Cecil, Al and Joey are celebrating the Fourth of July in Burleson! The Spazmatics, who have headlined Hot Sounds of Summer concerts in Burleson since 2010, are bringing their ultimate new wave 80's show to the City's Independence Day Celebration concert and fireworks. Don't miss the free family fun at Chisenhall Fields Sports Complex. The 90-minute concert starts at 7:30 p.m. on Thursday, July 4.

This is the third year in a row that Chisenhall Fields will play host to the City's Independence Day Celebration concert and fireworks show. Admission is free. The gates at 500 W. Hidden Creek Pkwy. will open at 5 p.m.

The day's celebration starts at 9 a.m. on July 4 with the Burleson Lions Club's annual parade. The theme is "Celebrating Our Military." The parade route winds from Irene Street to Gregory, Johnson, Ellison, Main, Bufford, Warren, Gregory, and back to Irene.

The evening of July 4, the Spazmatics will be set up in the field just to the right of the arched entrance to the sports complex. They will play until the lights go down to signal the start of the fireworks show, after 9:20 p.m. There will be lots of "oohs" and "ahhs" when the professionals shoot off traditional and low aerial fireworks, all choreographed to music.

Patrons may sit on the field surrounding the stage, in the bleachers and on most of the fields throughout the park. The concession stand will be open but patrons may also bring a picnic and beverages. No alcohol, glass bottles, pets, tents or canopies are permitted in the park. Fireworks, including sparklers, are also not permitted.
