The 46-year-old driver in the two-vehicle crash that killed a 60-year-old Rio Vista man Saturday morning has been arrested.

Burleson Police arrested Robert Dale Emerton of rural Burleson at the police department while he was there for an interview. The charge is intoxication manslaughter, a second degree felony punishable by a sentence of two-20 years in prison if convicted. Emerton is being held in the Burleson Police Department's holding facility on a \$150,000 bond. He will be transported to the Johnson County jail.

The arrest is in connection with an Aug. 3 fatality crash in the 3300 block of Southwest Wilshire Boulevard in Burleson. The victim was William Smith of Rio Vista.

Burleson Police and firefighters responded to a report of a crash at 12:21 a.m. Saturday morning involving two vehicles, with one person trapped. The vehicles include a 2000 Dodge Ram pickup driven by Emerton and a 2010 Ford Escape driven by Smith. The drivers were the only occupants of the vehicles.

According to the preliminary crash investigation, the Ford Escape was headed southbound and the Dodge Ram pickup was northbound on Wilshire Boulevard. The Dodge pickup went over into the southbound lane and struck the Ford Escape. The impact caused the Ford to roll on to its passenger side.

An investigator from the Johnson County Medical Examiners Office pronounced Smith dead at the scene at 12:42 a.m. Emerton was transported by Care Flite Air ambulance to an area hospital. Emerton was released from the hospital Saturday.
