Burleson Police have one driver in custody following a three-vehicle crash. Two people, including an infant, were transported to a local hospital with what appears to be non-life threatening injuries.

ARRESTED: Anna Maria Garcia, 23, Fort Worth

ARRESTED FOR: Felony evading arrest and four traffic warrants from Fort Worth Police Department

TIME/LOCATION: Saturday, Aug. 10, 4:15 p.m., Renfro Street at Wilson Street

A Burleson officer saw a 2001 Mercury Marquis speeding as it was southbound on Renfro Street, approaching the Alsbury Boulevard intersection. The driver turned left on to Alsbury and right on to Douglas. It was then that the officer found that the vehicle had an expired registration. The officer attempted to stop the Mercury, but the driver took off at a high rate of speed, running two stop signs in a residential area, then ran a red light at Hillery Street and Wilshire Boulevard/Hwy. 174. Hillery becomes Wilson Street. The Mercury then ran a red light at Renfro Street and Wilson Street, striking one vehicle, which then struck a second vehicle. A traffic signal pole was also struck, but the damage was to the button that activates the crosswalk.

The driver is in custody at the Burleson Police Department holding facility. The driver did not appear to be injured.
