The police department has a Burleson man in custody for aggravated robbery in connection with the armed robbery on Sunday, Jan. 19, at the Quick Track (Texaco) on Alsbury Boulevard.

Burleson police officers executed a search warrant at a north Burleson home shortly before 2 p.m. on Friday, Jan. 24. Charles Kevin Hughes, 37, was arrested on a Johnson County felony warrant for revocation of probation/third DWI and aggravated robbery.

Officers recovered evidence during that search warrant that included a handgun that linked Hughes to the Jan. 19 armed robbery. Evidence from the convenience store's surveillance camera also connected Hughes to the robbery.

The clerk called 911 at 10:56 p.m. on Jan. 19 to report that a man had robbed the convenience store at 701 N.E. Alsbury Blvd. The suspect displayed a weapon and demanded cash from the employee. The suspect left the store with an undisclosed amount of money. No injuries were reported.

Hughes' bond was set at \$50,000. He was transferred to Johnson County.
