A 47-year-old man died Thursday, March 13, as the result of a two-vehicle collision on Dobson Street.

TIME/DATE: Thursday, March 13, 2014 at 11:55 a.m.
LOCATION: 1100 S. Dobson St., Burleson, TX
DECEASED: Jon David Hayden, 47, Florida
SECOND DRIVER: Robert Guy Salts, 52, Fort Worth

According to the crash report, Hayden was driving a red Ford 500 passenger car that was registered to a Burleson resident. Salts was driving a white truck pulling a blue dump pup trailer that was hauling dirt/sand. The truck/trailer was registered in Fort Worth.

The truck and trailer were heading north on Dobson Street and Hayden was heading south in the same block. As Hayden approached the truck, a witness reported that he moved in front of the truck/trailer, which resulted in a head-on collision. The car veered to the right and ran into a fence, where the vehicle came to rest. Burleson firefighters used the Jaws of Life to free Hayden from the car. Hayden was flown by CareFlite Air to a Fort Worth hospital where he was pronounced dead at 12:55 p.m. Salts refused medical treatment.

Dobson Street was closed between Hidden Creek Parkway and CR 715 until after 9 p.m. on March 13 so officers could conduct a crash investigation. A hazardous materials company was also brought in to clean up the diesel spill.
