A Burleson man died July 15 at a Fort Worth hospital following a two-vehicle crash in south Burleson Sunday morning. The cause of death is still under investigation by the Tarrant County Medical Examiners Office.

NAME: Bobby Lee Dishman, 78, Burleson
TIME/DATE OF CRASH: Sunday, July 13, 2014, 11:44 a.m.
LOCATION: 2400 block of Southwest Wilshire Boulevard/Hwy. 174, Burleson

According to the crash report, Dishman was driving a green Mercury Cougar. He did not have any passengers. Ryan James Vanderwolde, 28, of Joshua was driving a gray Dodge Ram pickup. He was also a lone occupant.

The pickup was travelling southwest in the 2400 block of Wilshire Boulevard, in the inside lane. Dishman exited from a private drive, pulled in front of the pickup, and the two vehicles collided. Dishman was transported to John Peter Smith Hospital in Fort Worth. According to the Tarrant County Medical Examiners Office, Dishman died at 11:55 a.m. on Tuesday, July 15.

The contributing factor in the crash was failure to yield right of way from a private driveway.
