If you don't pick it up, who will? Come out and join the City of Burleson and Keep Burleson Beautiful with the Burleson Trash Bash on Saturday, Sept. 20. Your commitment of two hours, 9 a.m.-11 a.m., will make a difference. This is a semiannual campaign to beautify Burleson.

During the event, volunteers remove litter and debris from retail corridors, waterways, drainage channels, streets, parks, and other public areas. Volunteers of all ages are welcome, but youth participants are required to have adult supervision. After the cleanup, volunteers will convene at Warren Park, 301 S.W. Johnson Ave., for free pizza and some prize drawings.

Approximately 368 people donned their rain boots, slipped on some gloves, and armed themselves with trash grabbers and trash bags for the Burleson Trash Bash in September 2013. Groups fanned out across the city and picked up litter and debris that filled 190 bags – approximately 3,800 pounds of trash. The most unusual items collected include car parts, a mattress, and couch cushions.
