Burleson Police are looking for two suspects after an attempted robbery this morning at Fort Worth Community Credit Union on Wilshire Boulevard.

TIME/DATE: Monday, Nov. 10, 2014, 9:44 a.m.

PLACE: Fort Worth Community Credit Union, 1465 S.W. Wilshire Blvd., Burleson

An officer from another agency was working security in an off-duty capacity for the credit union. That security officer told Burleson Police that two individuals entered the business. The suspects were dressed in black, covered head to toe, and each was armed with a handgun.

The suspects got in to the credit union's vestibule. According to the report, the suspects saw the security officer inside the lobby. The suspects shot in the direction of the security officer, who returned fire. There were several employees in the business at the time, but there were no customers. No one inside the credit union was injured.

The suspects fled in a vehicle that was parked in front of the credit union. Burleson officers found the vehicle, which had been reported stolen from Dallas, abandoned behind the business. Officers searched the area for the suspects but as of the time of this release, the suspects had not been apprehended. Officers are checking for evidence on videotapes at the credit union and at surrounding businesses.

The police asked the Burleson Independent School District to put the campuses in the vicinity of the attempted robbery in a standby lockdown (nobody in or out, front doors locked, no students outside, and normal business inside the campuses). The BISD did a standby lockdown on all campuses, as a precaution. There was no danger inside any of the school campuses.

The FBI is responding to the scene.
