Do you want to learn more about grants? Then reserve two hours, noon-2 p.m., on Tuesday, Dec. 16. The Burleson Funding Information Center at the Burleson Public Library will present "Grantseeking Basics Brown Bag." Bring your lunch - no registration is required.

Grantseeking Basics is the Foundation Center's basic orientation to the foundation fundraising process. It is intended for representatives of nonprofit organizations who may be new to the process or want a refresher, and those who want to learn more about the Center and its resources.

The Center opened in May of this year. Nonprofit organizations and other grant seekers in Burleson looking for grant funding now have access to a valuable new collection of databases and print resources at the Library, which has become a Funding Information Network partner with the Foundation Center of New York. Whether you are looking for grants for your church, non-profit organization, or school or you are seeking grants to fund your education, the Library now has some powerful resources to help you in the process.

The Library offers free access to the Center's core collection of resources which includes Foundation Directory Online, profiling more than 110,000 U.S. grant makers, Foundation Grants to Individuals Online, Foundation Maps, print directories, and proposal writing guides.
